- Review orders for components and select what to use
- Utilize appropriate helper when working with large parts
- Verify and assemble product against sketches or drawings
- Assemble mechanical components for flexible furniture
- Assemble mechanical sub-assemblies
- Apply problem solving skills to trouble-shoot minor concerns
- Install and test hardware and plumbing fixtures
- Prepare electrical components for standard products
- Select and order steel parts as needed through our Kanban system
- Apply UL, QC or serial number labels as appropriate
- Select correct bolts or screws for assembly
- Make minor adjustments and repairs with little supervision
